The Community Dinner project seeks to bring our Shoreline neighbors together with local leaders and organizations to help inform and transform our communities. Many of us look around us and feel helpless or powerless to bring about any kind of change. Those who desire to get involved may not know how or where to get useful information and "be the change" in the community. By creating a space for civic leaders, local organizations can come and speak about who they are and what they are doing and, perhaps most importantly, how people can get involved.

Vision House's Good Work

// Taking care of our unhoused neighbors

Vision House works hard to get our unhoused neighbors off the streets and into a more stable situation. This support includes access to computers for housing and employment searches, guidance in navigating community resources, laundry and shower facilities, tangible items such as clothing and blankets, and support with grocery and transportation needs.

Vision House also provides their own transitional housing, and Calvin Church is one of their community partners. During the Summer of 2013, Calvin adopted a new apartment to create a warm, welcoming and healing living space for the women and children in Shoreline who need a temporary place to stay.
