## Life Bridge Ministries

*// One of Calvin's mission partners in Cambodia*

Many of us have known Chomno Prom for many years. When another of our Cambodian Mission partners — CUSP — started in Kampong Thom, Chomno served as an interpreter for the CUSP English Camp while he lived in the boys dorm. (More about CUSP next week.) Later, Chomno led the DOVE Onyx program in Kampong Thom.

Recently, Chomno and his wife, KimHeng, left DOVE and formed Life Bridge Ministries. They have planted a church, work with community pastors, and lead a large drop-in center for young people. It provides a safe after-school haven where they learn about the Lord, the English language, technology and more. Chomno and KimHeng have two beautiful children and are raising three additional teens who needed homes.

As you will learn throughout this Cambodia Emphasis month, all our supported partners in Cambodia interconnect to serve the Khmer people in unique yet complimentary ways.

## New Vision House Partnership

*// A message from the Deacons Financial Aid Committee*

This week a new partnership was established between Vision House and the Deacons at Calvin Church.

Instead of our Deacons interviewing people **outside of our congregation** who typically request aid for housing and utility costs, that work will now be done by Vision House personnel. These personnel have rich, ongoing expertise in assessing and helping people when they call with multiple material and psychological needs. This partnership is a win-win for Calvin and for Vision House. The most Calvin can do is offer a bandaid, rather than addressing the root causes of an individual's situation. Vision House has resources to help people break the cycle of debt and other factors that cause financial distress.

In compensation for this work, the Calvin Deacons have committed to making a monthly contribution to Vision House.

Rest assured, the Deacons will continue to assist Calvin congregants with financial matters and other needs.
