January Finance Summary

// General fund finances are on target for the fiscal year

Our General Fund remains in a healthy position. Expenses are as expected. We were a bit under target for contributions, but overall – thanks to continued growth in facilities revenue – we are ahead of the budget again. In fact, for the second time in over two years, we have a positive net revenue in our General Fund. We are so grateful for the generosity of our congregation!

// Here are the numbers for July 2025 – January 2026:

- General Fund Contributions: \$379,255 – 96% of target income;
- Facilities Revenue: \$65,999 – keeping our budget on track!;
- Other Revenue: \$27,212;
- Total Operations Revenue: \$472,466;
- Total Expenses: \$466,762 – giving to missions: \$45,422;
- GF Net Revenue: \$5,704 – positive net revenue!; and
- Total Assets: \$1,010,157.

When I read this, I think of my upbringing living in working class neighborhoods in Nashville and then in New England. I was always a social child and made friends easily, not caring how nice a car their family drove. My parents raised me this way.

My in-laws also were this way. They showed kindness to people of many different cultures and economic statuses. We learned from my husband's aunt working on the Navajo Reservation, helping teenagers stay out of trouble, adopting them, and teaching them art. My husband Richard and I also learned this as a couple as we helped veterans and others in trouble. I held these values in my heart working in community hospitals near reservations, and in Mexico taking care of people who had

very little. My mother's social activities were in my blood, and I went beyond my training to help people. I didn't even think about it.

As I get older, it becomes harder to do more volunteer work. So, I become more discerning and lean on God, asking for guidance each day. I ask how far HE wants me to go. I ask for strength, and HE gives it to me. If I feel sorrow, I ask for prayers and I pray myself. I'm able to go on. I lean on my church, my husband, and my social connections for prayers and help to carry on, now more than ever. I am finally where I belong.
