February Finance Summary

// A month to celebrate, by Kirsty Haining

This month, our General Fund is doing very well. We are at 99% of our target for contributions, and also at 99% of what we expected for operating expenses. Overall, we are ahead of the budget again – primarily thanks to our strong facilities revenue. This is especially gratifying for a budget year that we anticipated would be running a deficit all year long. We predicted we would have a shortfall of \$14,295 at this point of the year; instead we're ahead by \$18,510!

In my head I hear the melody of the Hallelujah Chorus playing, but my reason counsels caution. Sometimes Calvin has good months, and sometimes we have bad months. Revenue stream has become more unpredictable

as more and more people move to one-time annual gifts.

Even so, a good month is still worth celebrating. We are so grateful to God for his care of us, and to all of you for your generosity!

// Here are the numbers for July 2025 – February 2026

- General Fund Contributions: \$444,494 – 99% of target income!;
- Facilities Revenue: \$75,439 – still going strong;
- Other Revenue: \$31,586;
- Total Operations Revenue: \$551,519;
- Total Expenses: \$533,009 – giving to missions: \$51,015;
- GF Net Revenue: \$18,510 – positive again!; and
- Total Assets: \$1,021,912.
