April Finance Summary

// Pray for the budget process

Thanks to your generosity, things are still looking good for our General Fund. We are slightly ahead of the budget in income. Expenses are right on target, and we continue to be on track for ending the fiscal year well. God is good!

// The numbers for July – April

- General Fund Contributions: \$543,388 – 97% of target income;
- Facilities Revenue: \$83,673 – still doing very well;
- Other Revenue: \$41,765;
- Total Operations Revenue: \$668,826 – 102% of our budget target;
- Total Expenses: \$676,700 – giving to missions: \$65,211;
- GF Net Revenue: (\$7,874); and
- Total Assets: \$978,433.

Please continue to pray for Session and other ministry leaders as the budget is formed.

Certain issues need wisdom and discernment – such as Calvin’s long-term staffing requirements, the building’s maintenance needs, as well as a possible reduction in facilities revenue. These will impact the budget in our next fiscal year. Above all, we want budget decisions to be aligned with where God is leading Calvin. Pray for clarity of vision, purpose, and action.
