Vision House: Celebrating a Mission Partner

// A testimony from a Vision House Diversion Center beneficiary

Sharon, a mother of three, was working as a property manager when a serious car accident left her unable to work. Losing her job meant losing housing, and Sharon and her children – Amy, Simone, and Joshua – had to sleep in their car.

Sharon later secured an apartment, but rent drained her savings. After more than 100 job interviews, she received a 30-day eviction notice and knew she needed help. Thankfully, that is when Vision House's Diversion Center stepped in.

As Sharon worked tirelessly to regain stability, Vision House came alongside her by providing gas cards, groceries, pull-up diapers, and even a warm meal while she commuted nearly 20 miles for child care. With a Vision House team member to encourage her and guide her, Sharon secured a new job, avoided eviction, and got help covering back rent.

Today – thank God – Sharon and her family have stable housing again.

Thank you for supporting Vision House so that they could be there for Sharon when it was needed most. You are helping families like hers leave homelessness behind for good.
