2. To approve changes to the pastor's terms of call in the areas of salary and housing allowance.

### May Finance Summary

// Fiscal year-end is only a couple of weeks away!

May was yet another good month for our general fund. We are up to 99% of our target goal for contributions, and at 102% of the budget target for all revenue. Facilities revenue has surpassed the annual goal we set for this fiscal year. Expenses are again right on target for where we expected they would be. Thus, we continue to be on track for ending the fiscal year well. We are extremely grateful for your generosity and give thanks to God for his provision.

// The numbers for July 2025 – May 2026

- General Fund Contributions: \$608,821 – 99% of target income!;
- Facilities Revenue: \$83,310 – surpassing our annual goal!;
- Other Revenue: \$45,927;
- Total Operations Revenue: \$742,058 – 102% of our budget target;
- Total Expenses: \$751,161 – giving to missions: \$70,804;
- GF Net Revenue: (\$9,103); and
- Total Assets: \$965,711.

With just a half month left of this fiscal year, we encourage our congregants to fulfill their 2025–26 pledges or to make an extra gift before June 30.

It appears we will finish the year ahead of our budgeted goals. We are very close to eliminating a deficit for the year. Your generous giving in the coming weeks can help us achieve that goal.

You might have noticed that things are a little quieter around Calvin's campus now. That's because Medhane Alem Evangelical Church was able to purchase their own building – so they are no longer meeting here. They stopped gathering here at the end of May. Medhane Alem was extremely grateful to use our facility, and we were also glad that our facility could benefit them.

Our primary purpose in hosting guest groups is not to earn money, but the revenue we get certainly helps with the operating costs of our facility. The electric bill alone is over \$1,000 a month! Facilities revenue also contributes to

maintenance and repairs. So losing a revenue stream is a difficult thing, especially when making plans for a new budget.

Please continue to pray for our Session concerning the budget, personnel, and other matters. Session will be meeting next week for a second time this month in an attempt to resolve all the hanging issues regarding our upcoming fiscal year. As you know, we want budget decisions to be aligned with where God is leading Calvin. Pray for clarity of vision, purpose, and action.
