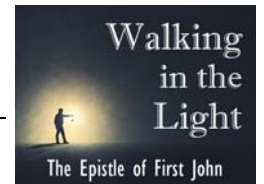

Suggested Questions for Individual  
Study or Group Discussion\*



- What does the word "life" mean to you? How do you measure the quality of your life?
- What are the "desires of the flesh, the desires of the eyes, and the pride of life?" (1 Jn. 2:16) How do we show our love for these things?
- Describe something in your life that you thought would last, but ended up fading away? How did that effect what you invest yourself into?
- What does it mean for us to "abide forever" (1 Jn. 2:17). How is that contrast with the things of this world in v. 16?
- What does the term antiChrist mean to you? How does John's description of many antichrists help to shape your understanding of this term (1 Jn. 2:18).
- What is that John is referencing "heard from the beginning" that we should allow to abide in us? (1 Jn. 2:24)
- Why do you think uses the word remain/abide so many times in 1 John 2:26-27? What significance does it's repetition have for you?
- What does it look like for you to abide in Christ? What steps could you take this week that might promote that?
