Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion*



- If you were given \$10,000 and told you must use it all for the growth and advancement of God's kingdom, what would you put the money toward? To whom would you give it and why? Would you hope for anything in return?
- In Philippians 4:10-20, what have the Philippians done that causes Paul to rejoice? How is their action also pleasing to God?
- What has Paul learned about contentment? What is his secret of being content (v. 11-13)?
- How would the promise of verse 19 be encouraging to the Philippians? How has this promise been borne out and proven true in your own life?
- Why is learning contentment important and necessary for growing our hearts? Why is contentment difficult? How do the Church and/or the culture help or hinder our learning to be content?
- In what situations or areas of life do you find it most difficult to be content? How can you employ Paul's secret (v. 13) in your present situation?
- How can the promises of verses 13 and 19 give you hope and help for the future? How will they inform your heart and financial decision-making, and how will they impact the way you give?
- How has your understanding of generosity changed over the weeks of this study? What steps will you continue to take to grow your heart through giving? How can your small group or others support and pray for you?



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
