Suggested Questions for Individual
Study or Group Discussion*



- Describe a place you have been where you were especially struck by the natural beauty. What does this place reveal to you about God as Creator?
- *Read Romans 8:18-25.* What is the present state of creation? How did it get this way (cf. Gen. 3:17-19)?
- For what is the whole creation waiting? What do Paul's analogies tell us about the future of creation?
- *Read Isaiah 65:17-19 and Revelation 21:1-5.* What do the messages of Isaiah the Prophet and John the Seer have in common?
- How will the new heaven and new earth have continuity with the way they are now, and how will they be different? How will both heaven and earth experience their own version of resurrection?
- What will be the future relationship of the earth and heaven (cf. Eph. 1:10; Col. 1:15-20)? What does this reveal about how God values both?
- How does this inform the way you answer the question, "Where do we go when we die?"
- If we will spend eternity on the new earth, how then should we treat creation now?
- What are some concrete actions you can take this week to practice creation stewardship, both enjoying and caring for our world? How can your small group or others pray for you and support you in this through the coming week?

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
