ANNUAL GROUNDS CLEAN UP

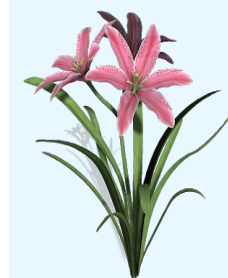
