Suggested Questions for Individual
Study or Group Discussion*



- If you could explore any country to which you have never been, where would you go and why?
- *Read Numbers 13:1-3, 13:26-14:10.* Who is Caleb, son of Jephunneh? How is Caleb both similar to and different from the others who explore the Promised Land (cf. 14:24)?
- Based on his words and actions, what can you deduce about Caleb's character?
- *Read Joshua 14:6-15.* What has happened in Caleb's life since his first trip to the Promised Land? For what does he ask now?
- How would you describe Caleb's relationship with the LORD God? How do you think it got to be this way?
- What quality of Caleb's character inspires you most or would you most want to emulate?
- What would it mean for you to follow the LORD your God wholeheartedly at this stage in your life (cf. v. 8, 9, 14)? What would need to continue, and what might need to change? How will you do that? How can your small group or others support and pray for you?

For Family Discussion: *Parents/guardians share about what kind of "report" you usually brought home from school and how you felt about it. Summarize Numbers 13:1-14:10, but read at least 13:30-33.* When have your problems looked like giants to you? When have you felt small like a grasshopper? How can we follow God wholeheartedly even when we are scared or discouraged?
