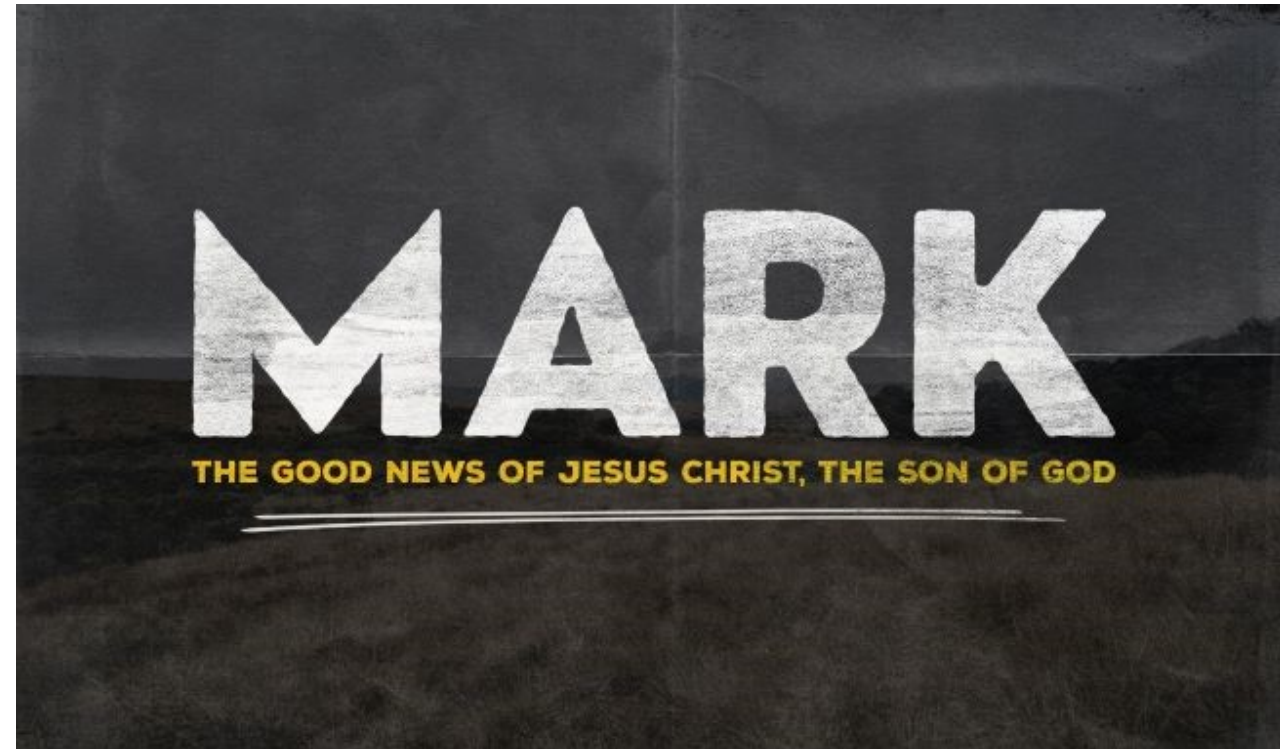
ENGLISH CAMP
