Sunday, November 3, 9 am & 11 am services

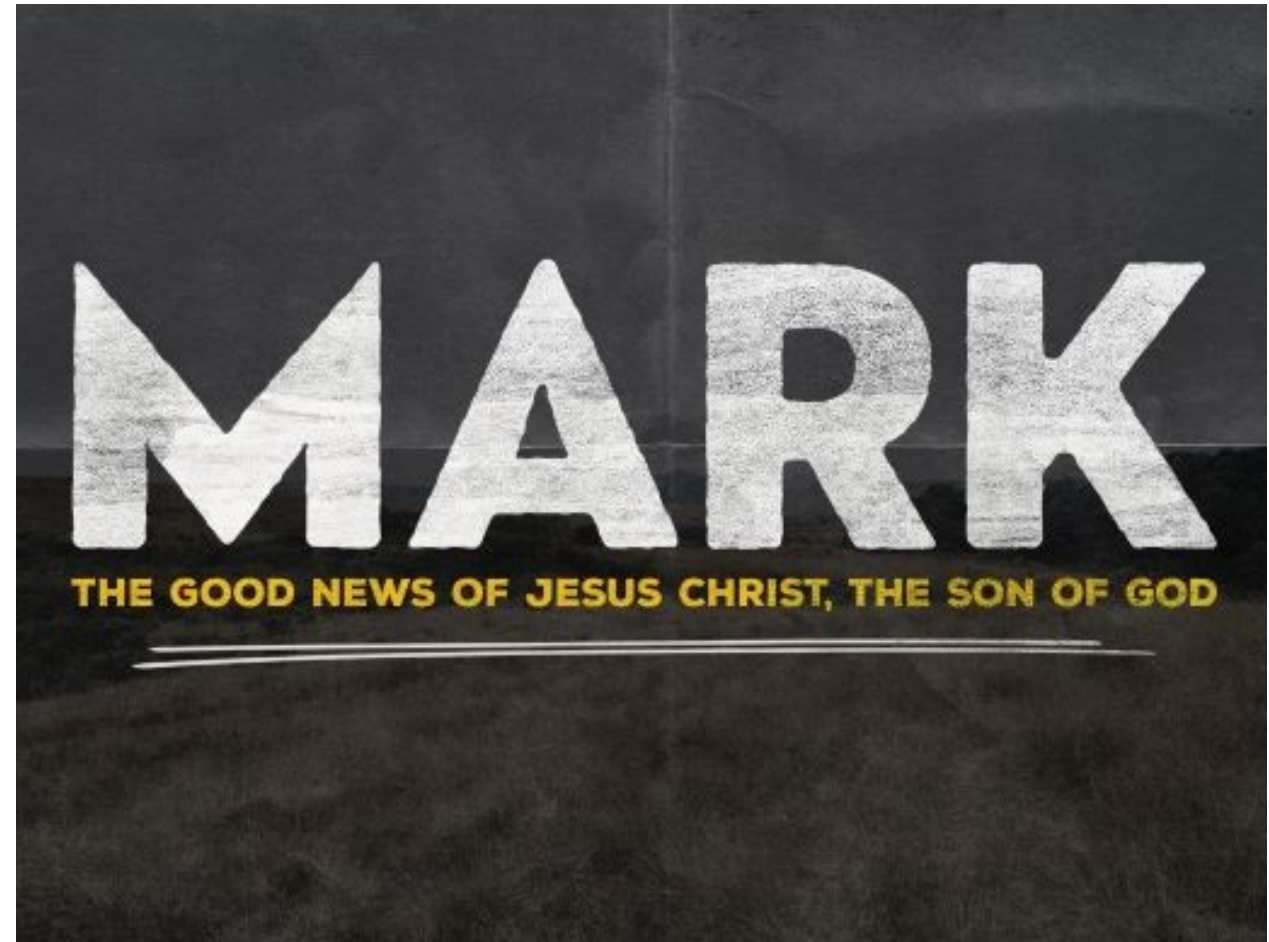
Join us next Sunday as professional Christian artist and internationally known speaker and representative for Compassion International, Grant Norsworthy will lead worship here at Calvin PC.
