Suggested Questions for Individual Study or Group Discussion*



- How would you define “righteousness”? What is it? What is required for a person to be righteous?
- *Read Isaiah 9:1-7.* What role will righteousness play in the kingdom of the One who is to reign on David’s throne?
- How does a king who rules with righteousness compare to those who lead and rule today?
- What makes Jesus righteous?
- How does Jesus make us righteous (cf. Rom. 3:21-24; 2 Cor. 5:21; Tit. 3:4-7)? What part do we play?
- In what ways can or should righteousness be a characteristic and goal of our relationships with other people?
- What would your life look like if you were more righteous? How will you pursue this? How can your small group or others support and pray for you as you do?

For Family Discussion: Ask: *Who are some of the most important people we have relationships with?* Read Isaiah 9:6-7. Explain that “righteousness” means being rightly related to God and others. Ask: *How is Jesus a righteous king? How does Jesus make right our relationship with God? What relationship with another person would you like Jesus to help you make right?* Pray together and ask the Lord to help make all our relationships right.
