Newborns through 3 years are welcome in our nursery (blue room in children's wing, always staffed by two volunteers), the Sanctuary, or the Quiet Room.

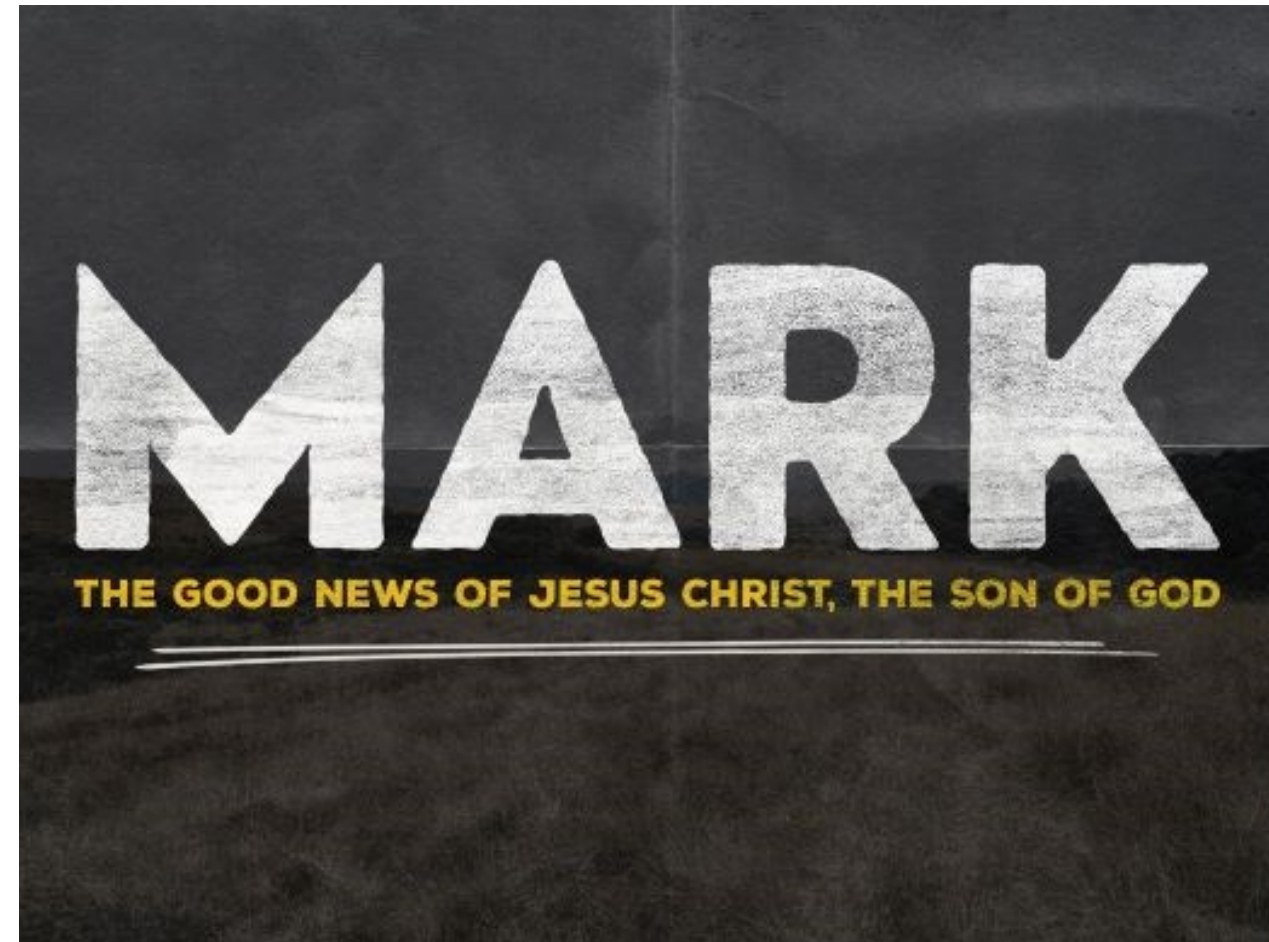


During the 9 am service, children and youth are invited to worship in the Sanctuary with their families.

During the 11 am service, children ages 3 through 5th grade will begin worship with their families in the Sanctuary. After the blessing of the children, they will go to their classrooms.

Parents/Guardians can pick up their children at the conclusion of the service in the red room (age 3 - 1st grade) or the purple room (2nd - 5th grade) on non-Communion Sundays.

On the first Sunday of the month, teachers will escort children back to the Sanctuary to experience the Sacrament as a whole church family.

The joining fee is \$40 a year. There are four spots to be filled. If you would like to join the team and enjoy eating fresh organic produce, contact Christi Nixon.

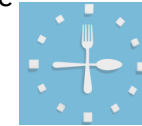
